Faculty and staff give students individual attention and assistance when they need it. Faculty and staff help students learn from their mistakes and overcome their challenges. |
| 1.2 Religious Formation/Catholic Identity | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students regularly learn about and experience the Liturgy and the Sacraments. Students are developing strong morals and character. Students have sufficient service and outreach opportunities. |
| 1.3 Technology Infrastructure and Educational Integration | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Technology is used effectively for teaching and learning. Students are learning cyber-values and digital ethics. Students are being prepared to thrive in the digital age. |

| 2.2 Opportunities for Stakeholder Input | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Parents have opportunities to participate in or contribute to school advisory committees: e.g., curriculum, budget, economic development, school improvement.• The school seeks input from parents on school policies and practices. |
